




# IPA CBC projects approved in the South-East planning region focus on the eligible transnational area as:

- Improved decision making and strategic planning by policy makers at local, national and regional level;


# Over 70 Projects realized by the Centre for development of the SEPR

# Number of projects realized by the Centre for development of the South-East planning region






