Dr. Aleš Hančič is the director of the TECOS Slovenian Tool and Die Development Centre. He has more than 12 years of experience in the field of research, management of research projects and organization management. He started his career as an assistant at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering of the University of Ljubljana. He joined TECOS in 2005, first as a young researcher, then as Director of Research and Development. In 2013, he was appointed director of TECOS, which he still manages today. In recent years, he was also employed as an assistant at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering of the University of Ljubljana, and as a research associate lectured at the University of Polymer Technology in Slovenj Gradac. He is an expert in the field of management of work processes, processing of polymer materials and development of bio-composite materials, but in recent years he has mainly devoted himself to company management, human resources, production processes and cluster management. He is the author or co-author of more than 70 scientific or professional works and has so far led more than 20 international research and development projects (FP7, H2020, ERA-Net, EUREKA, Interreg, etc.).
