Prof. Dr. Sandro Nižetić is a Full Professor at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture (FESB) at University of Split (Croatia). His research is in the field of energy, energy efficiency in buildings, smart technologies and renewable energy sources. He has worked on various projects related to the implementation of energy efficiency measures in public buildings under the auspices of UNDP (United Nations Development Programme). He also served as a Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Construction and Spatial Planning in the Croatian government, and also as Vice Dean of Research at FESB. Prof. Dr. Nižetić has organized and chaired several international conferences. He is the Editor-in-Chief of the Energy Sources Part A (Taylor&Francis), Associate Editor in the International Journal of Energy Research (Wiley) and Associate Editor in the Journal of Cleaner Production (Elsevier). Prof. Dr. Nižetić has published over 200 research and conference papers, as well as several techno-economic professional case studies. For his work he received several major awards including the Croatian State Prize for the research for 2016, as well as also Rector prize for research from University of Split for 2018 and 2020. Based on the Stanford and Elsevier ranking list he was among 2% of the World's top cited scientist in 2019 and 2020.
