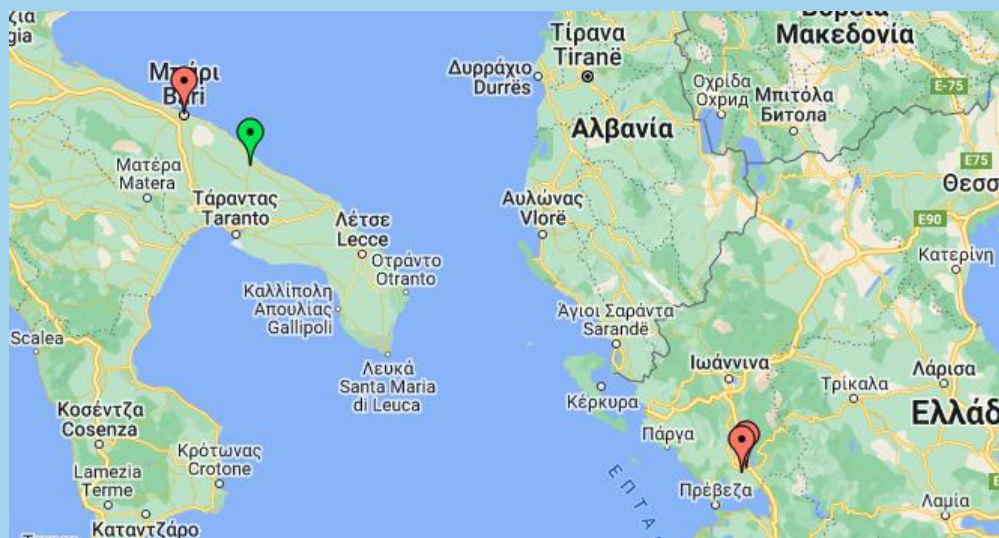
Target

- ✓ Installation of monitoring systems for the prevention and control of air pollution at multiple levels of territorial scale
- ✓ Improving combined, smart and safe mobility in the cross-border area
- ✓ Direct support to micro/family businesses, SMEs and start-ups for upskilling, digital competence development and organizational capacity (mentoring, coaching, etc.)
- ✓ Development and pilot implementation of tools which target on upskilling and retraining targeted groups, with a focus on digitization and greening the economy.

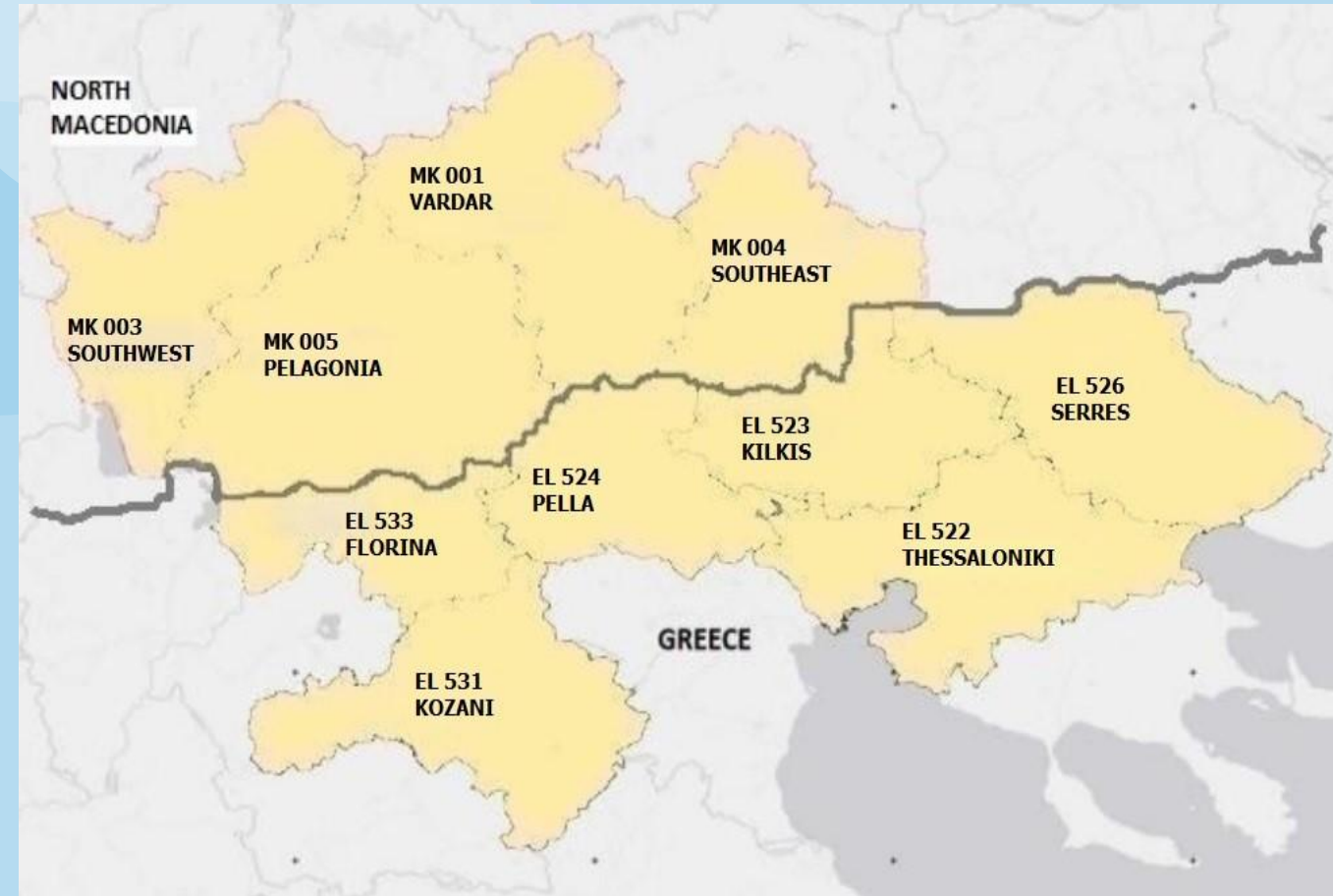

Indicative Actions

- Procurement of Information Communication and Technology (ICT) equipment for a new border crossing between the partner countries.
- Development of early warning and risk prevention mechanisms with the aid of Information Communication and Technology (ICT) tools.
- Management of protected areas and monitoring of water quality with the aid of ICT applications.
- Mobile health services and e-health services for the remote areas of the Programme area and for the vulnerable groups (children, elderly population, people with kinetic disabilities, etc.)
- ‘Digitalisation’ of cultural activities .
- E-Governance activities, including the digital delivery of selected public services.

Indicative Actions

- Develop common approaches in cross-border actions aiming at adapting regional skills to industrial transition, involving policy makers and all stakeholders of the Programme area.
- Developing cross-border knowledge hubs and innovative learning systems contributing the technology priority areas of relevant regional smart specialisation strategies (RIS3)
- Cross-border cooperation to share benefits of digitalisation in order to improve capacities and competences of SMEs and entrepreneurs in innovation management
- Strengthening cross-border cooperation with the view to promote the collection of data and big data, including cross-border maritime data in order to achieve evidence-based policy making.

Priority Axes

1. Protecting the natural environment, adapting to climate change with efficient green energy, preventing risks and reducing greenhouse gas emissions
2. Promoting socio-economic development through the enhancement of culture, sustainable tourism and social economy
3. Enhancing security and protection in the programme's area, through more effective integration of refugees and migrants

Indicative Actions

- Joint Risk Prevention and Disaster Protection Action Plans including research and innovation networks, exchange of good practices, know-how, etc.,
- Maritime space's data collection and provision through WEBGIS platform
- Innovative technologies' exploitation with the aiming of highlighting areas of touristic & environmental interest
- Digital literacy and distance educational activities for unaccompanied migrant minors to promote their social inclusion
- Strengthening the communication and investigation information systems towards an integrated border surveillance of the maritime space

2. Improving accessibility in the cross-border area
3. Fostering sustainable cross-border economic and social development

Indicative Actions


- Support of the digitalization in healthcare, including the supply of new and improved equipment for supporting telemedicine services, with a focus on remote and sparsely populated communities of the cross-border area. Efforts towards digitalization of health care services will be based in exchange of know-how and joint training in order to ensure cross-border dimension and impact.
- Development of information platforms, databases and tools for identifying missing links in health care services of the cross-border area, putting emphasis of the development and improvement of community-based services.
- Implementation of joint measures and tools, including development of cooperation networks for improving accessibility and effectiveness of healthcare and long-term social care services across borders with a focus on vulnerable groups.
- Improvement of physical and/or digital accessibility in historical monuments and sites of cultural heritage in the cross-border area, including for remote sites.
- Promotion of cross-border cultural initiatives (joint actions for common cultural identity, cultural events, digitalization of cultural content and cultural routes).
- Enhancement and promotion of cultural and creative industry (capacity building, training, promotion of cultural services, support of cultural and creative industry clusters, support of upskilling and reskilling for digital transformation of CCI).
