








The financial, human, and material resources used for the intervention.

Example 3: Money, staff, equipment Actions taken or work performed through which inputs, such as funds, assistance, and other types of resources are mobilised to produce specific outputs.

Example 1: Development of materials, training programs

Example 2: Drafting R&D research proposal

Example 3: Workshop on Cluster Internationalisation The products, capital goods, and services which result from an intervention.

Example 1: Booklets are produced, workshops held, people trained

Example 2: Research proposal is submitted and accepted

> Example 3: Contacts to international partners

The anticipated or achieved short-term and medium-term effects of an intervention's outputs.

Example 1: Skills/knowledge/ confidence increased

Example 2: Participants work on joint R&D project

Example 3: Organisation of business delegation The intended higher-level/ strategic project goals, towards which a contribution is to be made in the long term through an intervention
